MCA SASKATCHEWAN AND SASKENERGY OPEN JOINT TRAINING FACILITY

January 8, 2010 - Saskatoon is home to a new provincial natural gas trades training centre, designed to provide technical training to both SaskEnergy and private sector industry employees. The SaskEnergy Technical Training Centre was developed in partnership with the Mechanical Contractors Association of Saskatchewan (MCAS), which provided heating & mechanical equipment, mechanical contracting services as well as consultation during development of the facility.

The centre includes a technical training lab, classrooms, and the unique feature of all mechanical equipment used for heating, ventilation and cooling exposed, providing students with fully-functioning learning models.
